POSITION OVERVIEW: The BDHH is grateful to receive clothing, toiletries and other donations from the community. We need volunteers to help staff go through and organize those donations. Duties may include sorting and folding clothing, sorting toiletries, organizing overflow areas to create additional space and sorting through what we cannot keep. Items we cannot keep are donated to GoodWill. This is a great volunteer opportunity for those who are looking for a flexible way to help out in their community!

BDHH is in continual need of cleaning. Volunteer groups have the opportunity to clean our overnight rooms, where more than 100 people sleep every night. While guests are in charge of cleaning up the space around them, the rooms can never be too clean! Volunteers may be asked to do additional cleaning around the shelter, such as trash pickup around the neighborhood, depending on weather and age of group. This is a great opportunity for a group looking to do a service project. Children must always have chaperones.

- Work with backroom staff on what help is most-needed that day.
- Sort through donations.
- Organize overflow areas.
- Clean empty bins.
- Divide up what can and cannot be kept.
- Possibly lift heavy bags or boxes.

- Wear close-toed shoes and clothing appropriate for getting to work!
 Come with an open heart to best serve the needs of the day.

- Love thy neighbor. Respect the dignity of others.
- Before departing, log out and list volunteer hours (volunteer binder at front desk).
